THE RESULTS

YDC tracks and verifies each student's annual improvement through nationally recognized assessment testing (Slosson's DST: R and DST:M) at the beginning and end of each academic year.

99% Success Rate – nearly all of our 1st-2nd grade students gain the skills necessary to become independent readers.

6 Months in Math Gains — our 3rd-6th grade students gain over 6 months in mathematics during the course of the school year.

1.5 Years in Literacy Gains – our 3rd-6th grade students gain over 1.5 years in reading comprehension during the course of the school year.
